Right Hand of God

Greetings of peace my dear brothers, sisters, friends and most certainly my enemies in the name of the Almighty God, the maker and creator of both heaven and earth and his dear son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It is indeed an honor and a privilege one in which I do not take lightly or for granted, to talk about the one in which the Almighty God the father said according to the holy scriptures in the book of Matthew 3:17 in which it says, "And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." For the scriptures says in John 3:16-17, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved." Since the beginning of time, the father has let it be known how he felt about his son according to John 3:35-36 in which it says, "The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand. He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him." Having this in mind and in our hearts according to the holy scriptures, we can understand the scripture found in the book of Romans 5:1-2 in which says, "Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God."

As pertaining to the topic being "the right hand of God," it is important to hear, understand, accept and believe what the holy scripture says pertaining to this particular topic in its entirety and not base it off of what man or woman has to say by their own ideology, theology, philosophy, interpretation or own rhetoric in which contradicts scripture. For the holy scripture says according to the book of Matthew 24:30-31, "And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." According to Luke 24:50-51 it says, "And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his

hands, and blessed them. And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven." Now let's look at the book of Mark 16:19 in which it states, "So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God."

Read: Revelation 1:7-8 & 17-18 and Acts 1:9-11

Now it has been taught down the years and still is being taught to this day, that the right hand of God or being at the right hand of God, that God was in the power of his own might but that is not exactly true. You see, God himself is power but the scripture says that someone is at the right hand of God or sitting at his right hand. For the holy scriptures says in the book of Exodus 15:6, "Thy right hand, O LORD, is become glorious in power: thy right hand, O LORD, hath dashed in pieces the enemy." The right hand of God has been put in power. For the holy scriptures says according to the book of Psalms 98:1-2, "(A Psalm.) O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory. The LORD hath made known his salvation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen." When it says the right hand or holy arm hath given him the victory it means salvation as in salvation is through and by the right hand and holy arm of God. For the scriptures says according to the book of Isaiah 59:1-2, "Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear." It further states in Isaiah 59:15-16, "Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment. And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him."

Read: Isaiah 63:5, Revelation 5:1-7 & verse 13 and Matthew 1:17-23

The right hand of God and the arm of God is a position of power that the father put his only begotten son in. For it says in the holy scripture written in the book of

Psalms 118:15-16 it says, "The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly. The right hand of the LORD is exalted: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly."

Read: Acts 2:30-38

You see the father said to the son to, sit on my right hand. Now power (God) gave him (son) power. So, the son of God is the one that received the power from the one with the power. For the book of Philippians 2:5 says, "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:" The reason that it is not robbery for the son to be equal with the father is because the father gave it to him and highly exalted him and he is the express image of his person and sprang from the bosom of the father. The right hand is a position of power but it is referring to the one in power. For the book of Hebrews 1:8 says, "But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom." According to Matthew 28:17-18 it says, "And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted. And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth."

Read: Mark 14:61-62, Matthew 26:63-64, Hebrews 8:1, Matthew 8:28-32

Even the devil knows who Jesus truly is. You see, we need Jesus because we cannot defeat what we can't see. For it says Romans 8:34, "Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us." We need an intercessor to speak on our behalf because we cannot come before a righteous God. This is even in the natural because we cannot speak to the judge on our own behalf, we need a lawyer, advocate, intercessor to speak the language in which the judge can understand. In the spirit it is the same way as the natural, we need someone to speak on our behalf and that someone is Christ. The book of Hebrews 4:15 says, "For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but

was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin." The scriptures also says in the book of Isaiah 64:6, "But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away." This is why we need the intercessor Christ to speak on our behalf to the father because even in our best day in righteousness we are still as filthy rags which means we are not holy enough. God cannot tolerate sin and a lie cannot tarry as in remain or be in existence in his sight. If we don't have the knowledge of what God did by giving his son to die for the sins of the world, to hell we are going.

Read: Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, 2 Corinthians 5:17-21, Hebrews 10:1-14, Acts 2:29-38, 1 Corinthians 15:24-28, 1 Peter 3:21-22, 1 Timothy 3:16, Colossians 3:1, Colossians 2:12, Proverbs 4:7, Hosea 4:6, Acts 7:55, Ephesians 1:20-23, and lastly John 5:22-23

Having the knowledge of what the body of Jesus Christ represents and how it is in comparison and relation to the church being believers of the testimony the father had of the son who sprang from the bosom of the father by eliminating the memory of the son of God, then you have just eliminated the church. For the book of Colossians 1:23-24 says, "If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister; Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church:"

Read: Colossians 1:14-22

Although the body of the son of God came later on, the very thought that God would indeed send the son into the world was always the plan and will of the father and this son who sprang from the bosom of the father was before the man Adam. Mary birthed a body being the son of God who is Emmanuel being interpreted God with us but the son been here since the beginning with the father and that must be

understood by all people. For the book of Colossians 2:18-19 says, "Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God." In this very verse it is warning us not to let anyone turn us away from worshipping who it is that we are supposed to be worshipping. My brother and sister if you happen to lose a leg or two or an arm or two, you can still live but if you lose your head and your head is detached from the body, then the body has got to die. You see the devil is trying to sever as in to separate or detach you from the head who is the son who is the head of the body which represents the church.

Read 1 Corinthians 1:12-20 and Ephesians 4:13-24

My brother and my sister be it known unto you, that if you eliminate the body of Jesus Christ you eliminate the church because the church is the body of Jesus Christ and Jesus Christ the father's only begotten son is the church's head. Now the flesh and blood son of God is no more but the very existence, knowledge, evidence, proof and testimony of the father pertaining to the son has to be kept in memory. Flesh and blood died that was the natural and when he was resurrected that was flesh and bones and when he ascended back up into heaven and parted/taken out of the sight of his disciples, now he is all spirit but to many people this is a great mystery.

In conclusion my brothers and sisters I encourage you all to do as it says in the HOLY SCRIPTURES according to Isaiah 55:6-7, "Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon." For it says in Isaiah 30:21, "And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left." John 8:32 says, "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Revelation 2:4-5 & verse 7 says, "Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou

hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God."
