Salvation is in the name of Jesus Christ God's only begotten son

Greetings of peace my dear brothers, sisters, friends and most certainly my enemies in the name of the Almighty God, the maker and creator of both heaven and earth and his dear son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I count it all joy, honor and indeed a privilege to speak the truth and lie not from that which is written in its entirety in the holy scriptures pertaining to salvation being in the name of Jesus Christ the only begotten son of God. First and foremost it is very important to first mention what it says according to the book of Acts 4:10-12 in which it says, "Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. The holy scriptures reference to the only begotten son of God as the son of God, son of David and even then son of man but all of these mean the same thing and are about the same only begotten son of God from the father. What people have done is try to make these 3 mean 3 different things as a way to say that they are not all talking about the only begotten son of God but they are. Jesus Christ is known as the son of God, son of man and son of David. When the veil is removed from your eyes you will be able to see the only begotten son of the father Jesus Christ from Genesis to Revelation. According to the gospel according to Luke 24:44 it says, "And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me." You see my brother and my sister the entire holy book of scriptures all point to the only begotten son of God Jesus Christ. For it says in Hebrews 10:7, "Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God."

My question to those who do not believe that the holy book of scriptures from Genesis to Revelation is directly talking about or pointing to the only begotten son

of God is who is it referencing to and who is it about? The very fact that people say that it is not about the testimony of our Lord God Almighty testifying about his only begotten son goes against and is against the record of the father (God) pertaining to his son (Jesus Christ).

According to Luke 1:28-35 it says, "And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man? And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God."

Read Matthew 22:41-45, Matthew 1:1 & 17-23 and Matthew 16:13-17

Jesus Christ is the son of David, son of man and the son of God and he is my Lord and my God. He is the father's only begotten son but he is my Lord and my God. To separate the son of man, son of David from the son of God is equal to separating a girl from a female or a boy from a male in which there is no separation. If someone says I have 3 girls that is equivalent to saying I have 3 females. If someone says I have 3 boys that is equivalent to saying I have 3 males. To say that the son of God, son of man and son of David are different when they are all about the only begotten son, is to say that you have more than one Jesus. Just how did the only begotten son get to be the son of David, well according to Matthew 1:1 in which deals with the genealogy of Jesus Christ says, "The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham." David was the father of the house that Jesus came from.

According to Daniel 3:24-25 it says "Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonied, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king. He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God."

In Daniel 7:13-14 it says, "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed."

For the holy scriptures says according to John $3:13^{th}$ verse & 18^{th} verse, "And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."

Read these scriptures to further support how son of man, son of God and son of David are used interchangeably as is female to girl and male is to boy.

Read: Acts 7:55-59 - Who did Stephen see?

Hebrews 4:14-15 - Who passed into the heaven?

Revelation 1:12-18 - Who is seen in the midst of the seven candlesticks?

Revelation 2:1-2 & the 18th verse - Who are these scriptures pertaining to?

John 6:48-69 - In these verses it references son of man and son of the living God, so if they mean something different from each other, why are they both used to describe the only begotten son of God Jesus Christ?

John 1:1-3 & the 14^{th} verse - Who is the word that was in the beginning with God that was made flesh?

Psalms 100:3 - Who is this verse talking about? Is it talking about God, the father or Jesus Christ, the only begotten son of the father?

Luke 2:11 - Who was born in the city of David? Was it the father or the son?

Hebrews 1:4-6 - In these verses, did the father become his own only begotten son and call himself father and son or did the father become the father of the only begotten son in which was made so much better than the angels in which he sent into the world to atone for our sins and remain as the father and called his "firstbegotten" or "only begotten" son, son which sprang from the bosom of the father?

As you can see, son of man, son of David, son of God all point and refer to the exact same one who is the only begotten son of God and his name is Jesus Christ and he is my Lord and my God.

Hopefully by now you can better understand, hear and believe that the son of David, son of man and the son of God all mean the same thing as they all point to or directly speak about God's only begotten son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

In conclusion my brothers and sisters I encourage you all to do as it says in the HOLY SCRIPTURES according to Isaiah 55:6-7, "Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon." John 8:32 says, "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Revelation 2:4-5 & verse 7 says, "Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God."
