Sent or Became

Greetings of peace my dear brothers, sisters, friends and most certainly my enemies in the name of the Almighty God, the maker and creator of both heaven and earth and his dear son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It is indeed an honor and a privilege to talk about the one in which the Almighty God the father said according to the holy scriptures in the book of Matthew 3:17 in which it says, "And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." Since the beginning of time, the father has let it be known how he felt about his son so much to the point that by his only begotten son Jesus Christ according to Romans 5:1-2, "Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God."

For the word of God teaches us according to 1 John 4:9-10, "In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins." This very scripture lets us know how God the father showed and demonstrated his loved toward us which is by sending his only begotten, son of God into the world. For it says in the book of Isaiah 53:1-10, "Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his

mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand."

Now as it pertains to sons, God has many sons but he only has one only begotten son. For the scripture says according to the book of Romans 8:14, "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God." For it also says in 1 John 3:1-3, "Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure."

You see Jesus the only begotten son of God was introduced to the world when the father sent him but he was still on the mind of the father to do as a way to redeem us from sin to reconcile us back unto the father as in to restore the relationship between God the father (creator) man and woman (creation). Now just because this was indeed new to the world, it was not new to God for this had been on the fathers mind already because he knew from the very beginning that man would fall because he as in the father knows all things. If the son existed on the mind before he was sent into the world, just what was the son's function you may be wondering? Well, to answer that question I will answer with the scripture found in John 1:1-3 in which it says, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made." So the father's only begotten son who is the only begotten son of God existed as the word that was with God that was made flesh because remember Jesus said I and my Father are one. For example if I was to send my son to let's say Virginia and I live in California, my son didn't start becoming my son when he got to Virginia but he was

my son back home in California. Although my son may be new to those who live in Virginia because he is just visiting carrying out a message/errand from me his father, he was still my son while he was with me in California but he is just now being introduced to those who live in Virginia. However, my son was still my son before I sent him and before he entered into the love state of Virginia. This is the same way as it pertains to the father and his only begotten son. Listen reader hear me very closely and clearly. I can send my son to Virginia but I cannot become my son and my son cannot become me. The father sent the son and the father did not become the son nor did the son become the father but they are indeed one.

(Read John 6:37-43 & John 6:48-58)

For the holy scriptures says according to the book of John 4:34, "Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work."

(Read John 5:30-40 & the 43 verse)

For the holy scriptures says according to the book of John 17:1-5, "These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was."

If you can't see the gospel which is the death, burial and resurrection of the only begotten son of God whom the father sent to the world, you are lost. When it says that the father sent the son into the world, this lets us know that the existence of the son of God existed before his body did and before Mary his mother and before the world was created. By the father preparing a body of the son of God and put himself in that body and sent the son into the world, this means the son was sent to die for the sins of the world. Now the only way death can do anything with Jesus Christ the only begotten son of God, Jesus Christ had to humble himself to death

to die to be the atonement for the sins of the world to redeem us from the sinful place in which we were all in due to the fall of Adam in the garden of Eden when he rebelled, disobeyed the very commandment of God in the garden of Eden. For Jesus Christ the son of God has been declared as eternal life. How can you kill eternal life? For the holy scriptures says in 1 John 5:20, "And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life." Read also 1 John 5:11-13, "And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God." The holy scriptures further says in the book of John 10:17-18, "Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father." It also says according to the book of John 5:22-29, "For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live. For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation." For the holy scriptures says according to 1 John 5:20, "And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life." So not only is the only begotten son eternal life but the father has also committed all judgement unto the son that the son gets the honor just as the father gets the honor because remember he said according to John 10:30, "I and my Father are one."

According to the book of Acts 10:38 it says he was anointed, just read the verse in which it says, "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him." According to the book of John 4:25-26 it lets us know that he is the messiah, read the verse in which says, "The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he." Jesus Christ is the messiah and the anointed one. Once upon a time perhaps you didn't know this and God pardoned it but now that you do know you are held accountable the very moment you become and are made aware of the knowledge of God the father and the father's dear son, Jesus Christ. For the scriptures says according to Acts 17:30-31 says, "And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead."

(Read John 17:1-5 & John 17:14-23)

Most people will say that when the son of God said that he finished it, that everything about the son of God died on the cross but this isn't true at all. When the son of God said it is finished, he was referring to the work that the father gave him to do in the earth while he was in the flesh and blood but that didn't mean he himself being the son which sprang from the bosom of the father stop existing when he said it was finished and dropped his head and died because if he is in the bosom of the father and existed as the word being in the beginning with God being God, he still exists today. He even had work to do after he died on the cross and yielded up the ghost to the father.

Read 1 Peter 3:18-20 in which it says, "For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison; Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water."

Read Matthew 27:50-53 in which it says, "Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent; And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many."

The very existence of the son of God is eternal being on the mind of God as the plan to redeem man from sin to reconcile us back to the father so that the relationship can be restored between creator and creation and this couldn't be possible without the suitable, perfect and acceptable sacrifice. Although the flesh and blood is no more because he died to atone for our sins because without the shedding of blood there is no remission, the son that came from the bosom of the father still exists because he is God and God cannot die because God is a spirit. Read John 1:18 and John 4:23-24. The son is still working on our behalf and everyone ought to be glad because we need a mediator to speak on our behalf to the father. Read Hebrews 7:19-28, John 3:16-21, John 8:41-47 & John 8:51-58, John 1:1-3 & John 1:14-17. The only begotten son of God finished his earthly assignment, work or task but he is himself is not finished and he is still working.

Read Revelation 19:13, Ephesians 3:9, Hebrews 1:1-8.

Whenever you hear SON, word, Jesus Christ, they all are referring to the only begotten son of God who is my Lord and my God. Read the holy scripture according to John 20:24-31.

Again to reiterate before my son was sent by me to Virginia, he still was my son back home in California. Before the only begotten son was sent into the world by the father, he was still the only begotten son in the bosom of the father. Now

before the first begotten was flesh and blood, in the beginning he was the word that was with God because he is God and all things were made by him.

Read John 1:1-3, & verse 14, John 9:35-41 and Matthew 28:16-20

My brothers and my sisters, it is too late in the hour to deny what the Holy Scriptures says about the son of God. For the Holy Scriptures says according to John 7:38-39 and this was Jesus Christ the only begotten son of God speaking, "He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)" I hope and pray that after reading all of this that you now have a better understanding of sent and became and that sent doesn't mean became and that became doesn't mean sent.

Read Proverbs 4:7, Hosea 4:6, John 8:32 and John 8:36

In conclusion my brothers and sisters I encourage you all to do as it says in the HOLY SCRIPTURES according to Isaiah 55:6-7, "Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon." For it says in Isaiah 30:21, "And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left." John 8:32 says, "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Revelation 2:4-5 & verse 7 says, "Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God."
